Synopsis

```
TMSS10ValidateBarcode [-C customer ID] [-M media ID] [-S logon string]
```

Description

TMSS10ValidateBarcode will parse a list of volume barcodes, outputting the barcode rule the barcode will be parsed under if valid.

Options

- -C Default Customer ID.
- -M Default Media ID
- -S The logon string argument sets the [Server logon information](#)

Files

stdout: Output Reports.

stderr: Diagnostic messages.

stdin: Program input.

Example

Command line syntax

```
TMSS10ValidateBarcode -S user:-password@server -C "US02" -M "LT0"
```

Once you have run the above code, enter in the barcodes to be parsed either manually, via cut and paste or barcode scanner.
