## **Command Line Volume Filter Argument**

The volume filter argument sets the Volume Filter which can be used to filter the traversal of Customer, Media and Volume values. The format of this filter is c.m.v@r+f, where c is Customer-ID filter, m is Media-ID filter, v is Volume-ID filter, r is Repository-ID filter and f is the flag filter.

If the -V filter is not assigned a value it assumes the default of -V "\*.\*.\*" which will, by use of wild card value, include all volumes. Each of the values within the filter can be left as a wild card or assigned a value. ==== Examples ==== To process all volumes only in Repository ACME <code> -V "\*.\*.\*@ACME" </code> To process all volumes not in Repository ACME <code> -V "\*.\*.\*@!(ACME)" </code> To process all LTO volumes for customer US01 in repository ACME with an encrypted\*\* flag

-V "US01.LT0.\*@ACME+E"
