

# Printing Barcodes

## Printing Volume Barcodes

The appropriate method for printing Barcodes from TapeTrack depends on the type of barcode required - fully qualified, unqualified, Zone-ID or Slot-ID.

### Fully Qualified Barcode

Fully Qualified Barcodes can be printed from TapeTrack TapeMaster using the TapeTrack Barcode Printer.

## Printing Slot Barcodes

Currently there is no provision to print slot barcodes directly from TapeMaster. However, as slots are simply allocated a numerical sequence 000000, 000001, 000002 etc.

A text file with slot numbers (slot ID:Text) and text identifier (alphanumeric barcode representation) can be imported into the Barcode printer from the menu File→Open.

To create large groups of slotID:description fields for importation it is recommended to use Excel auto fill feature.
