

# Overview

The TapeTrack Slack App allows you to query tape libraries and move tapes from one location to another by all from within [Slack](#).

## Prerequisites

1. A Slack Account
2. Open Data Protection API (ODPAPI) Adapter for TapeTrack or URL of an existing Adapter.
3. [TapeTrack credentials](#).

## Connecting the App

To install the App simply click the App icon on the slack app directory.

## App Commands

### Adapters

Before you can use the TapeTrack slack App you must first add at least one ODPAPI Adapter.

#### Adding an Adapter

##### Syntax

```
/tapetrack adapter add name adapter_url
```

##### Example

```
/tapetrack adapter add test testuser:testuser@testbed.tapetrack.com/dpapi-v1
```

#### Listing Adapters

##### Syntax

```
/tapetrack adapter list
```

## Deleting an Adapter

### Syntax

```
/tapetrack adapter delete name
```

### Example

```
/tapetrack adapter delete test
```

## Libraries

### Listing Libraries

#### Syntax

```
/tapetrack name library list
```

#### Example

```
/tapetrack test library list
```

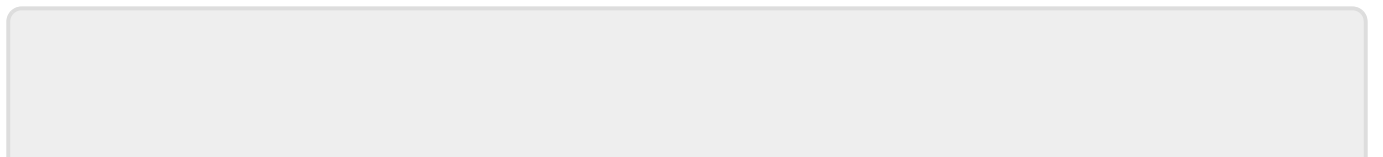
### Libraries Information

#### Syntax

```
/tapetrack name library info library_uuid
```

#### Example

```
/tapetrack name library info library_uuid
```
