Prerequisites

TapeTrack Lite

TapeTrack Lite must be installed and functional.

Configuring a Server

TapeTrack Lite requires that you have a [connection to a TapeTrack Framework Server](#). This Server may be running in your own company, or it may be provided by your offsite vendor.

When you start TapeTrack Lite, if you have no existing Servers defined you will be asked to [configure a server connection](#).

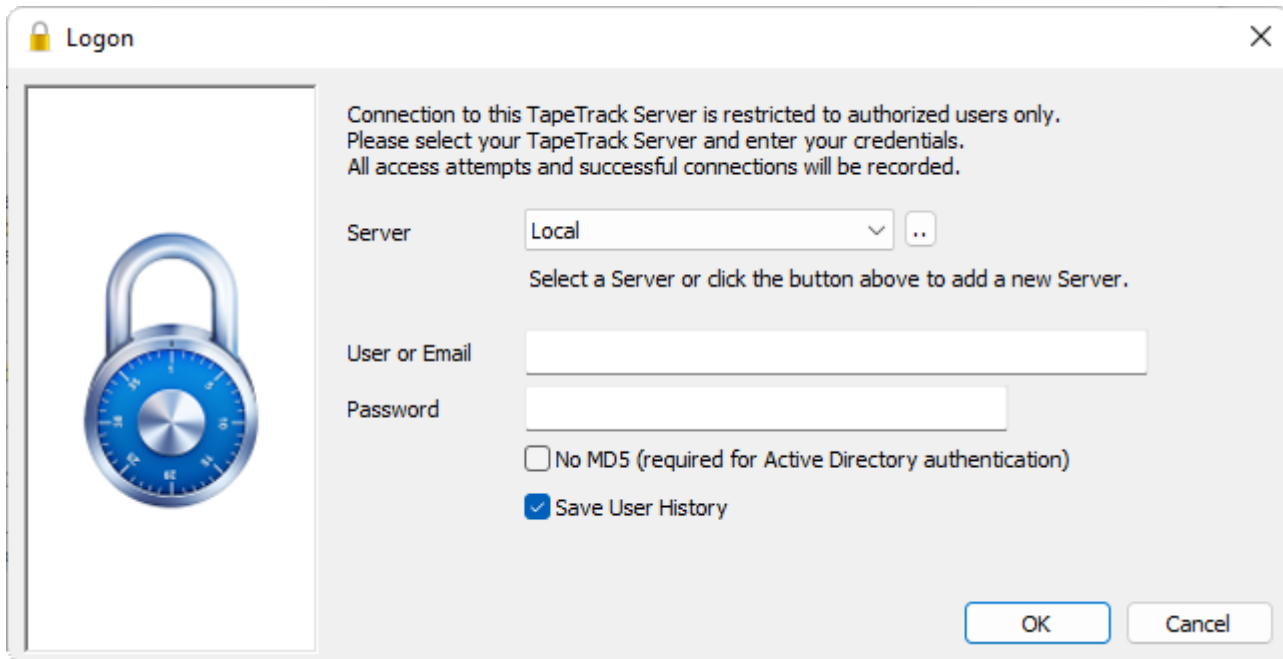

Logging on

Each time you start TapeTrack Lite you will be presented with a login window.



You will be required to enter credentials (a [User-ID](#) and [Password](#)).

Without these credentials, you will not be able to use the software.

Basic Functions

- [Scan-In](#): Receiving Volumes in to your location.
- [Scan-Out](#): Recording Volumes being shipped out from your location.
- [Send](#): Placing Volumes into a move out of your location.
- [Recall](#): Requesting offsite Volumes to be returned from an offsite location.
