Creating and Editing a Zone

Overview

A Zone is a TapeTrack Object which represents a physical storage location. Once created a Zone is then mapped to one of more Repositories to facilitate one or more contiguous physical storage locations for a given virtual location.

This section will explain to you how to create a Zone, and will also explain in detail how to set each of the Zone Properties.

Creating A Zone

From the Main Menu, select Administration→Zone Administration.

The Identity Tab

In the Identity tab the Zone properties are:

- **Zone ID** this represents a 1 to 10 character assignable ID for the Zone.
- **Zone description** this represents a long form description of the Zone.
- Total number of slots this represents the total number of slots that the Zone contains.
- Number of slots per row (optional) this represents the number of slots in each row of the Zone.
- **Customer filter (optional)** this defines which Customers will see the spesific Zone when assigning Zones to a Repository.
