



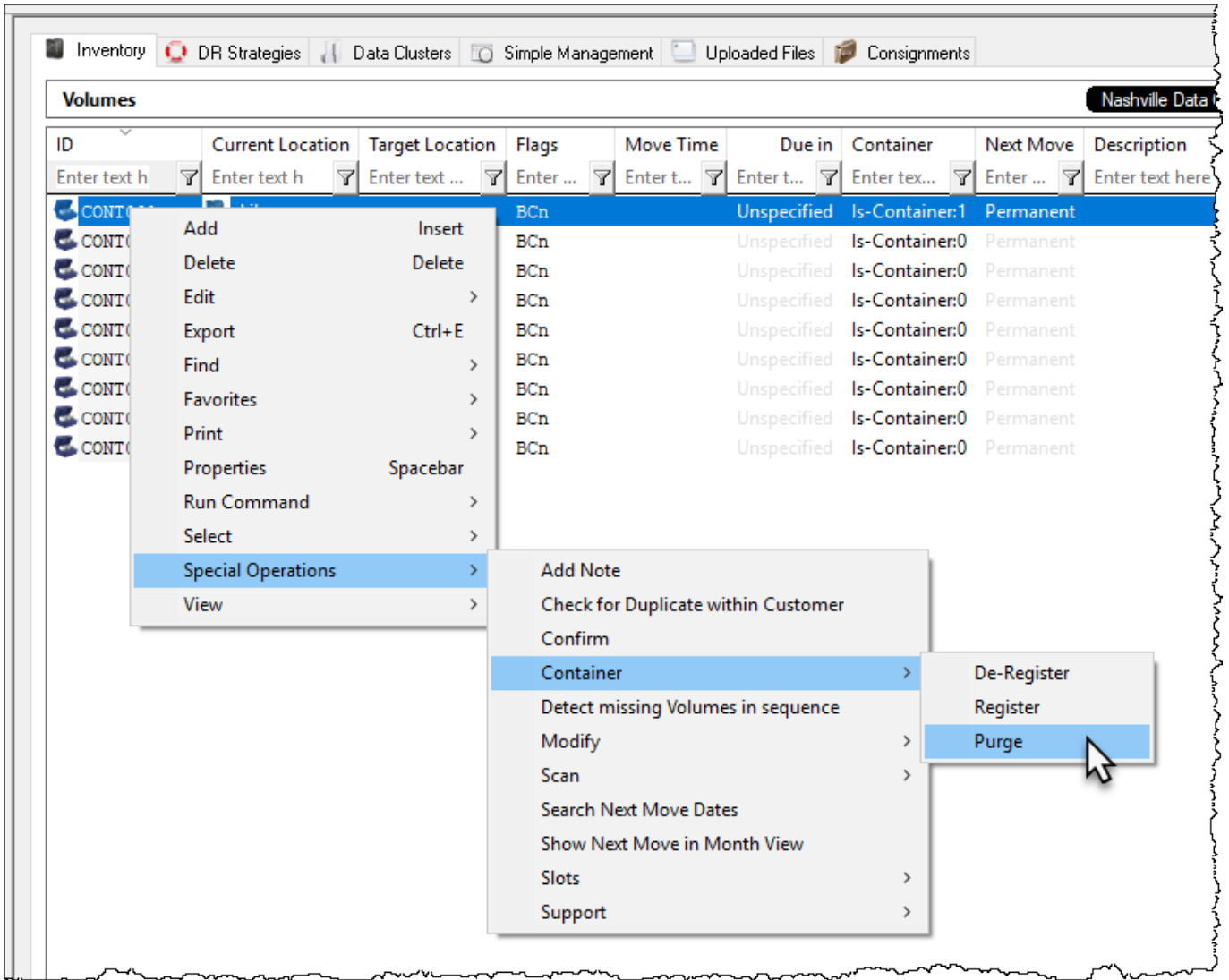


Click OK to remove the volumes from the assigned containers and exit back to the inventory window.

## Remove Volumes Via The Container Media Inventory Window

### Purge Container Contents

Select required container/s and right click, select Special Operations → Container → Purge



Then click Yes to **Confirm purge** popup.



### Remove Volumes Via The Container Properties Contents Tab

Right click and select Properties, or double click, the required container.

Select the Container Contents tab.

Select the required volume/s from the displayed list, right click highlighted volumes and click Remove From Container and Save to close window.
