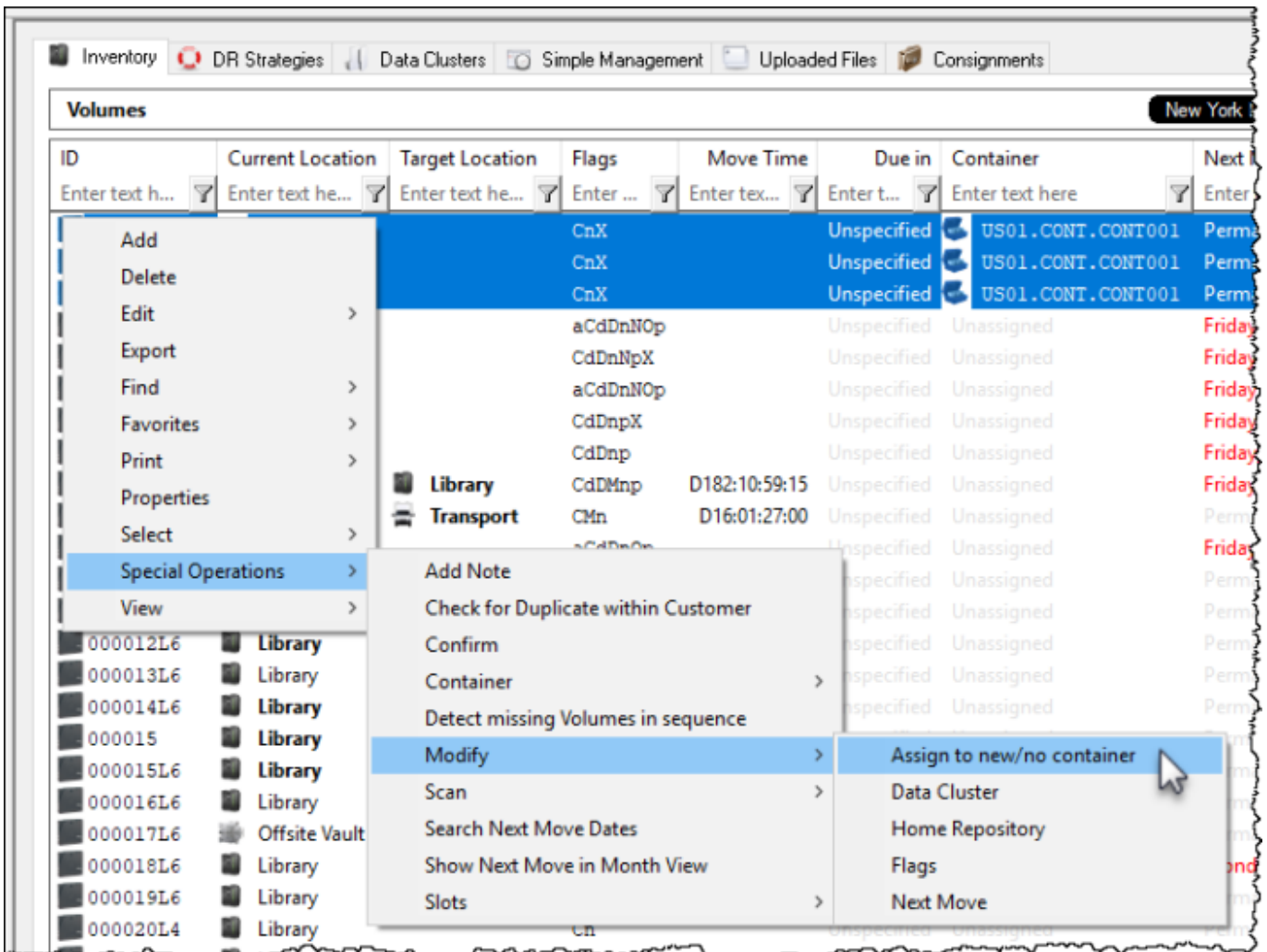


Remove Volumes From Container

Remove Volumes Via The Volume Media Inventory Window

Select a volume or range of volumes (Shift+Click and or Ctrl+Click) from the inventory window to remove from container/s. Volumes assigned to different containers can be selected and removed at the same time, there is no need to select one container at a time.



From the **Container Selection** window check the Select No Container checkbox at the top left. This will remove the displayed containers.

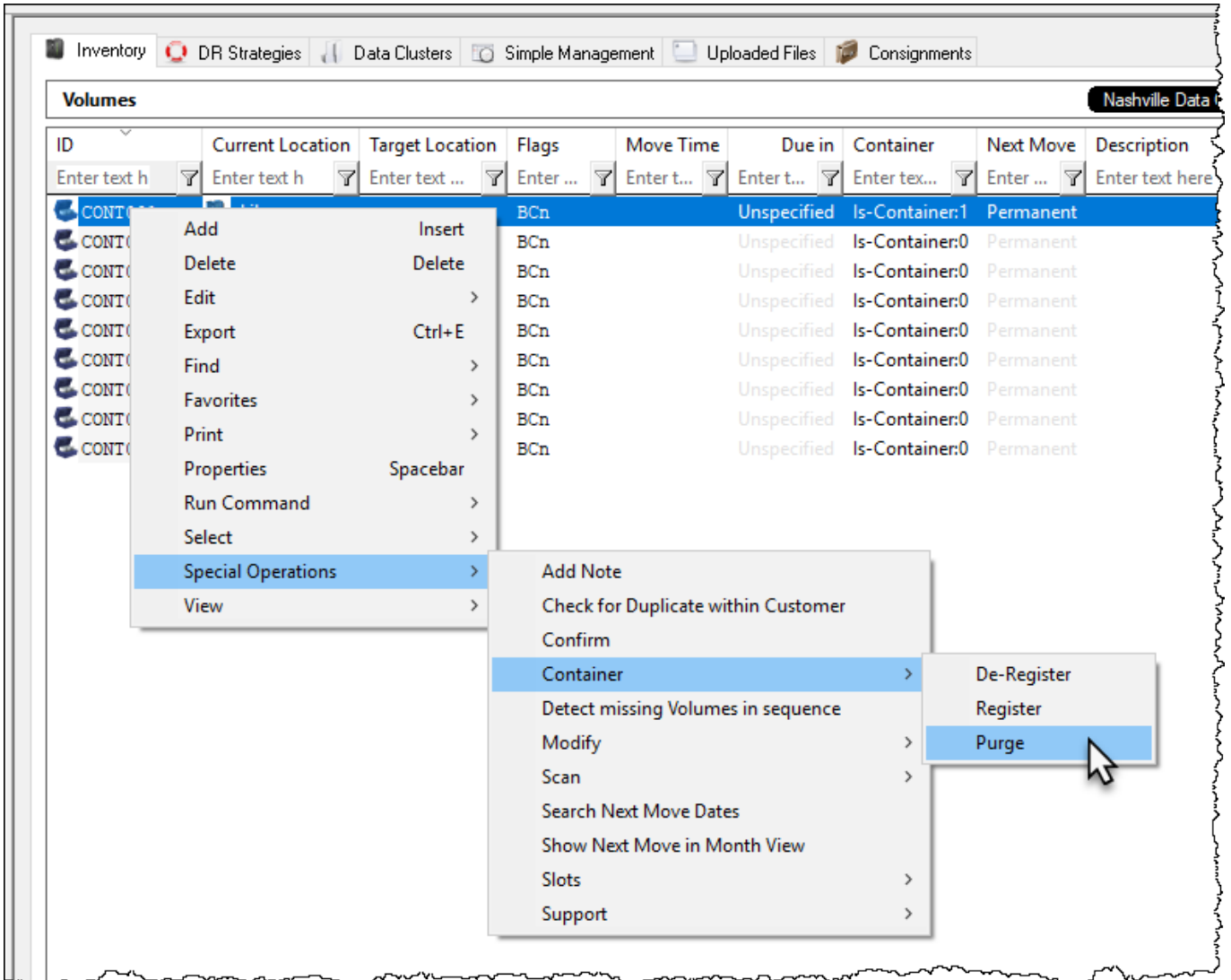


Click OK to remove the volumes from the assigned containers and exit back to the inventory window.

Remove Volumes Via The Container Media Inventory Window

Purge Container Contents

Select required container/s and right click, select Special Operations → Container → Purge



Then click Yes to **Confirm purge** popup.



Remove Volumes Via The Container Properties Contents Tab

Right click and select **Properties**, or double click, the required container.

Select the **Container Contents** tab.

Select the required volume/s from the displayed list, right click highlighted volumes and click **Remove From Container** and **Save** to close window.
