

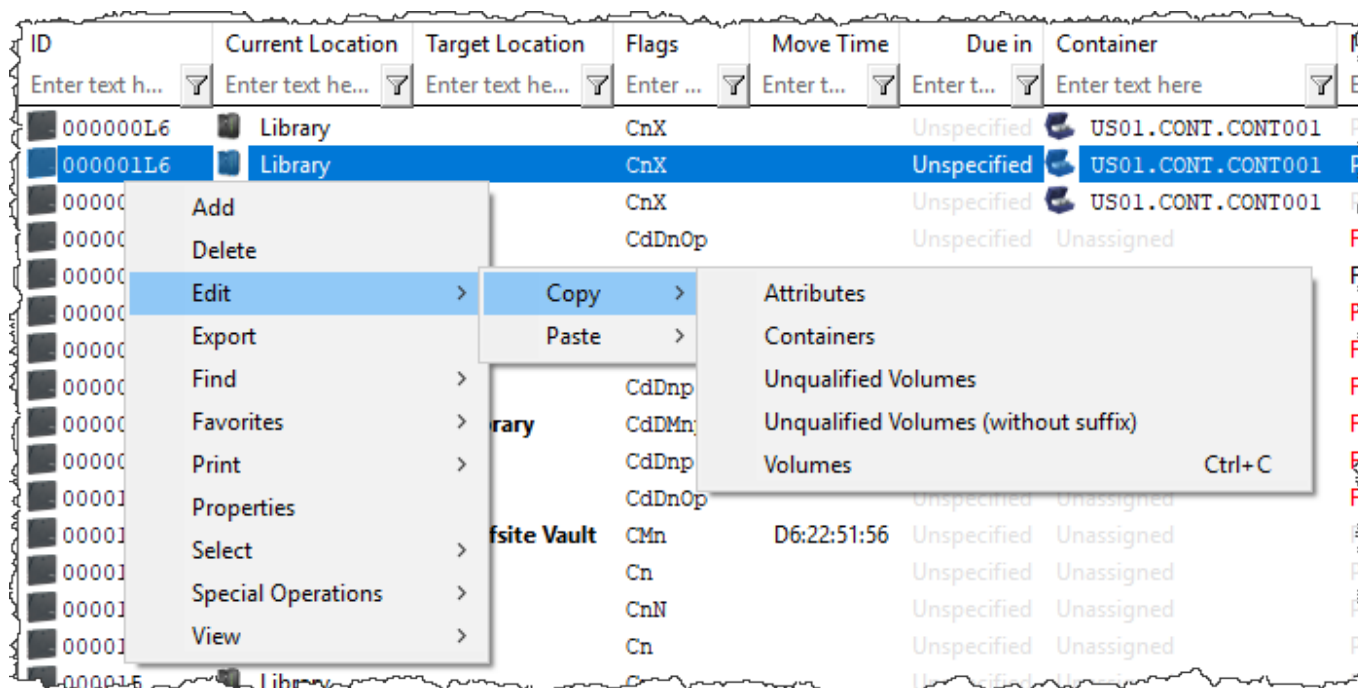
# Edit

The Edit Menu can be accessed by right-clicking selected [Volume\(s\)](#) in the [Volume List](#).

## Operations

There are two operations available under the Edit Menu: **Copy** and **Paste**.

## Copy



The Copy function will take one of four pieces of information and add it to the clipboard. In Windows, a clipboard is a selection of information that can be applied to a field using the Paste function.

Five types of information can be copied from selected volume(s).

- **Attributes** Selecting Attributes will copy the currently displayed attribute/s. To change which attribute is displayed refer to [Volume List Properties](#).
- **Containers:** Selecting **Containers** will copy a Volume's Container information and add it to the clipboard. If any of the [Volume\(s\)](#) selected are not assigned to a container nothing will be added to the clipboard for those entries.
- **Unqualified Volumes:** Selecting **Unqualified Volumes** will copy a [Volume-ID](#) without its [Customer-ID](#) or [Media-ID](#).
- **Unqualified Volumes (without Suffix)** will copy a [Volume-ID](#) without its [Customer-ID](#) or [Media-ID](#) or suffix. **\*\*Volumes\*\*:** Selecting **\*\*Volumes\*\*** will copy the selected [\[\[master:volumes\]Volume-IDs](#) to the clipboard. This function will include the [Customer-ID](#) and [Media-ID](#) when using the paste function outside of the [Volume List](#).
