


Volume Properties Window

The **Volume Properties Window** contains information and administrative controls for each individual **Volume**. It can be accessed by right-clicking on a **Volume** in the **Volume List** and selecting **Properties**. This can also be done by either hitting the space bar on your keyboard or double-clicking the a **Volume** in the **Volume List**.



There are twelve tabs in the Volume Properties Window.

- **Identity**: Displays the **Customer-ID**, **Media-ID** and **Volume-ID** for the selected **Volume**.
- **Target Location**: Displays the **Repository** and **Slot** that a **Volume** is moving to if it is in a **Move**. If a **Volume** is not in a **Move**, this will be the same as the **Current Location**.
- **Current Location**: Displays the **Repository** and **Slot** where a **Volume** was last confirmed. If a **Volume** is not in a **Move**, this will be the **Repository** where the **Volume** should physically be.
- **Scanned Location**: Displays the **Repository** and **Slot** where a **Volume** was last scanned or confirmed. If a **Volume** is not in a **Move**, this will be the **Repository** that the **Volume** is from.
- **Notes**: Displays Notes about the selected **Volume**.
- **History**: Displays all transactions that have occurred with the selected **Volume**, including Date,
