# Examples

With a [String pattern](#) of L6 will remove the suffix from Barcode 100234L6, to scan as 100234.

With a [String pattern](#) of L\* will remove the suffix from Barcode 100234L4, 100234L6, or any Barcode ending in L? (where ? is a wild card to match one character)
