1. Database management
2. Authentication and access control
3. Logging

Supported Platforms

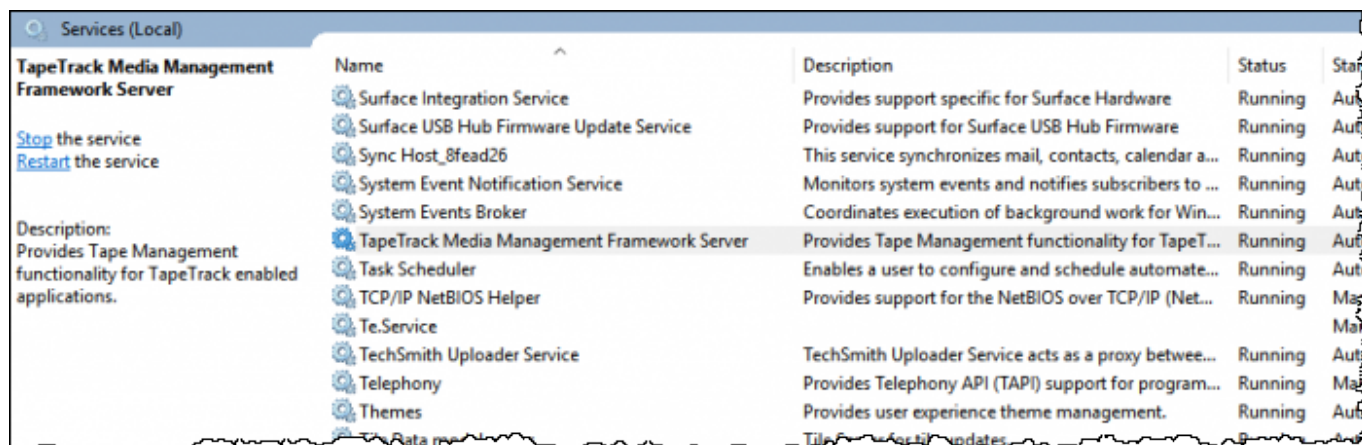
