

# Starting and Stopping the Service

When performing tasks such as server maintenance it may be necessary to manually start and stop the TapeTrack Service.

## Windows

### DOS Prompt

From a DOS prompt started as Administrator you can run the following commands:

```
Microsoft Windows [Version 10.0.14393]
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C:\WINDOWS\system32>net stop TMSS10SVC
The TapeTrack Media Management Framework Server service is stopping.
The TapeTrack Media Management Framework Server service was stopped
successfully.

C:\WINDOWS\system32>net start TMSS10SVC
The TapeTrack Media Management Framework Server service is starting.
The TapeTrack Media Management Framework Server service was started
successfully.
```

### Windows Service Manager

### TapeTrack Server Helper

Run the TapeTrack Server Helper App and press the Start or Stop Button in the Server Control Section.
