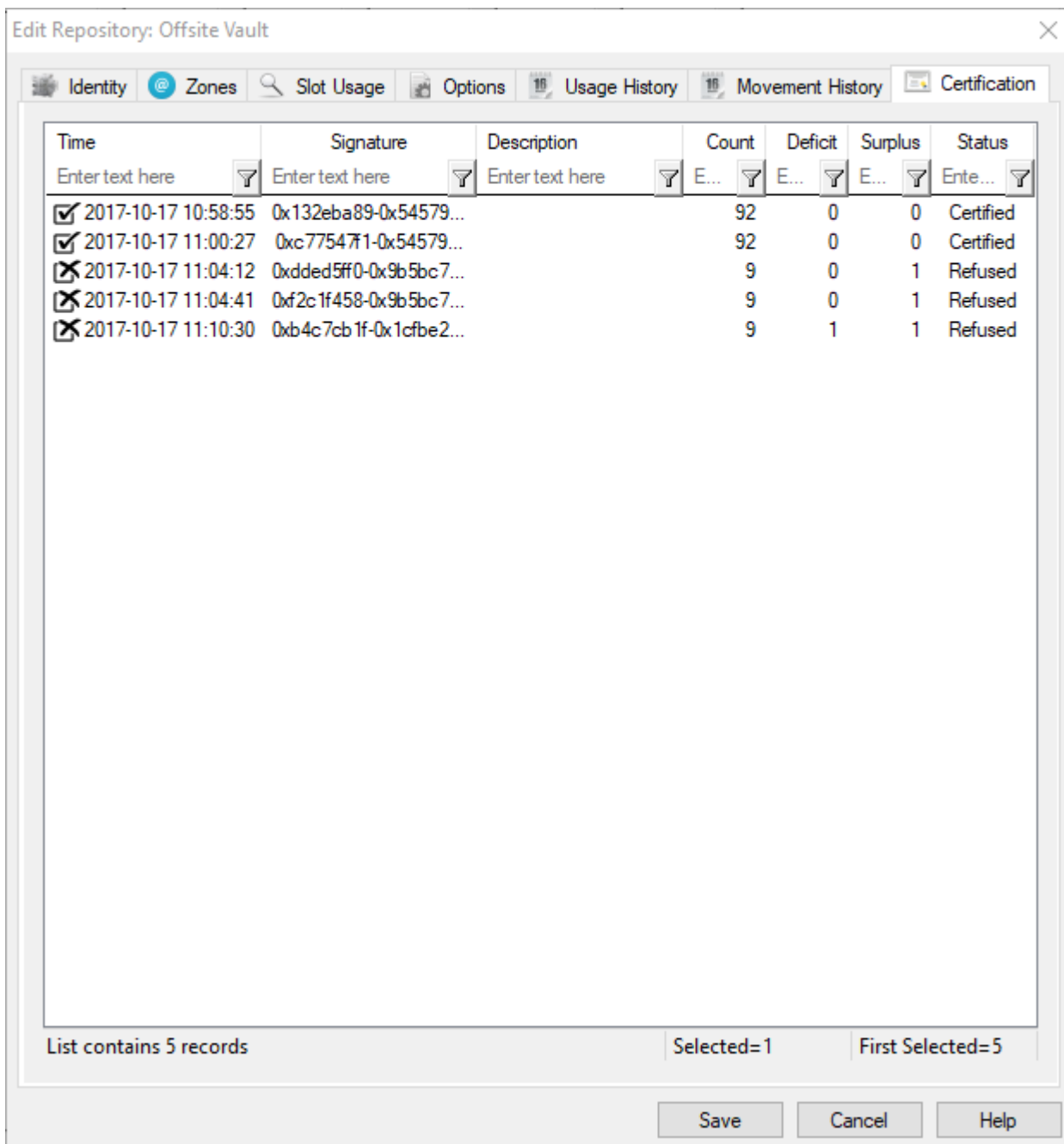


Certificates and Certification

In TapeTrack, a **Certificate** is a digitally-generated form that indicates whether or not a **Repository** is performing adequately. **Repositories** can either receive a Certified status or a Refused status. **Repositories** gaining a Certificate Refused status have Audit Failures due to either surplus **Volumes** or deficit **Volumes**.

certificates that have previously been **generated** can be viewed on the Certificate tab.



- **Time** displays the date and time the certificate was produced.
 - A tick indicates a successful certification.
 - A cross indicates an unsuccessful certification.
- **Signature** displays the certificates unique digital signature.
- **Description** displays the description (if any) of the certificate.
- **Count** displays the deficit count of volumes.

- **Deficit** displays the deficit count of volumes.
- **Surplus** displays the surplus count of volumes.
- **Status** displays certificate's certified or refused status.
