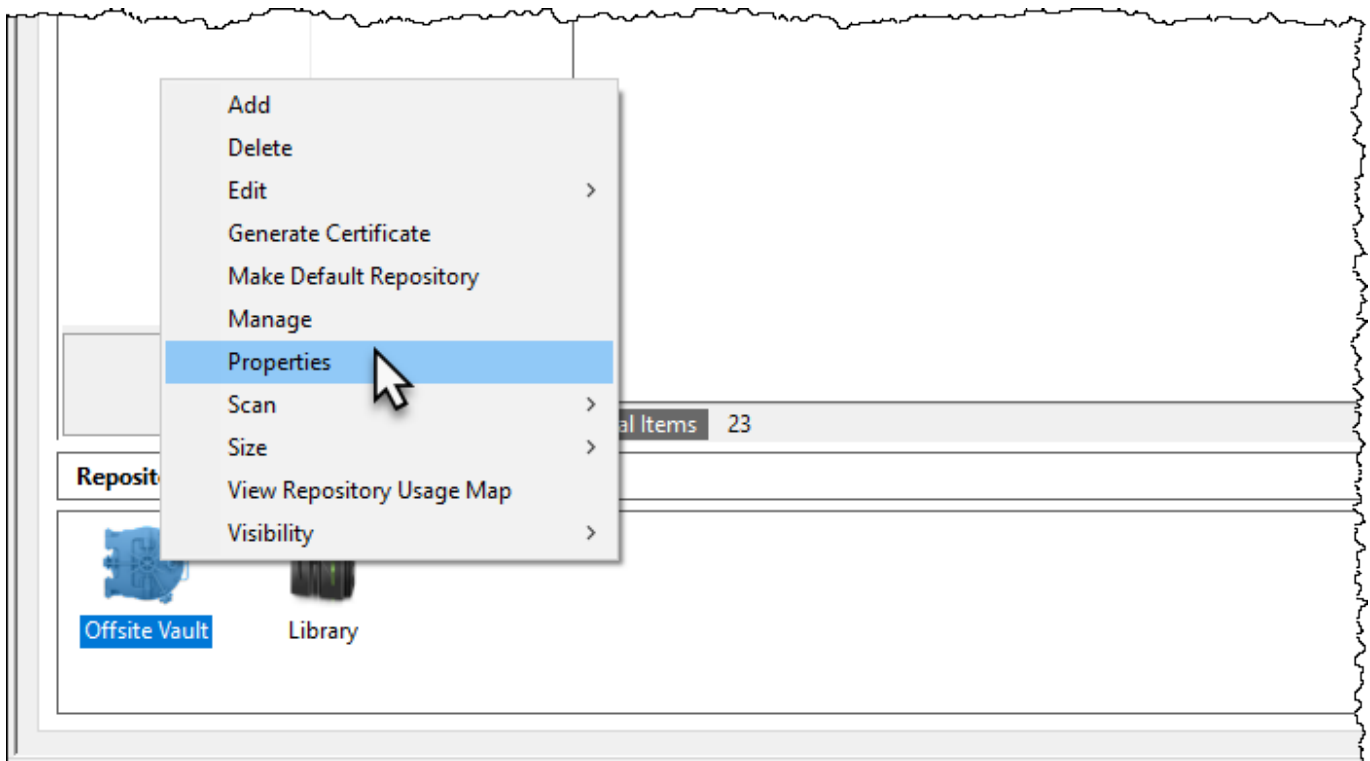

## Exporting Certificates

### Selecting Certificate For Export

Select the Customer's Media type in TapeMaster, right-click the required Repository and select [Properties](#), or double click to open the [Repository's](#) Properties window.



Select the [Certificates](#) tab to view all previous [Reconciliation Certificates](#).

Select [Certificates](#) by clicking, or Range select multiple [Certificates](#) using Ctrl+Click and/or Shift+Click.

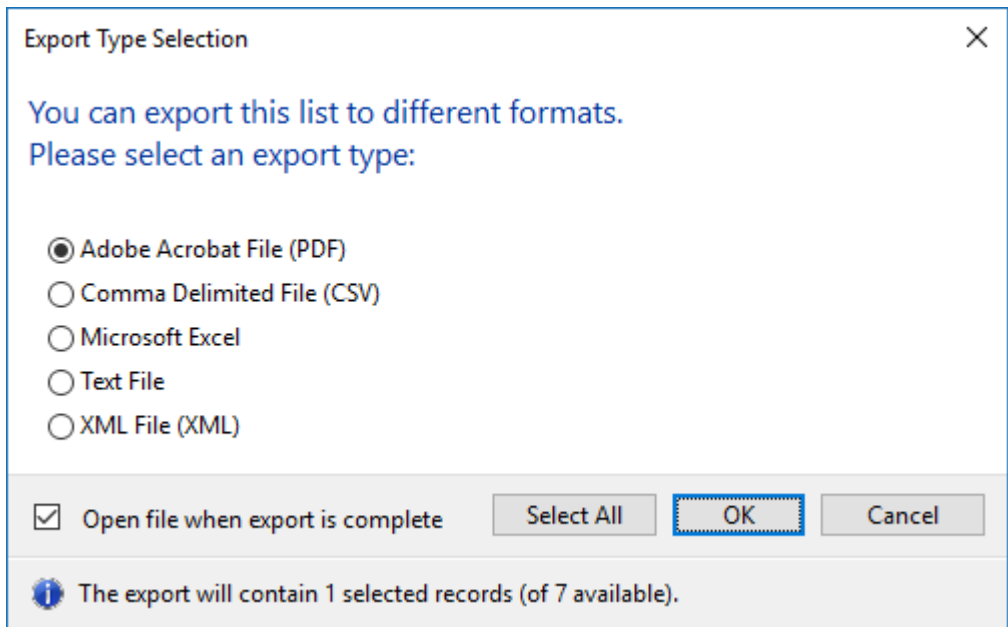

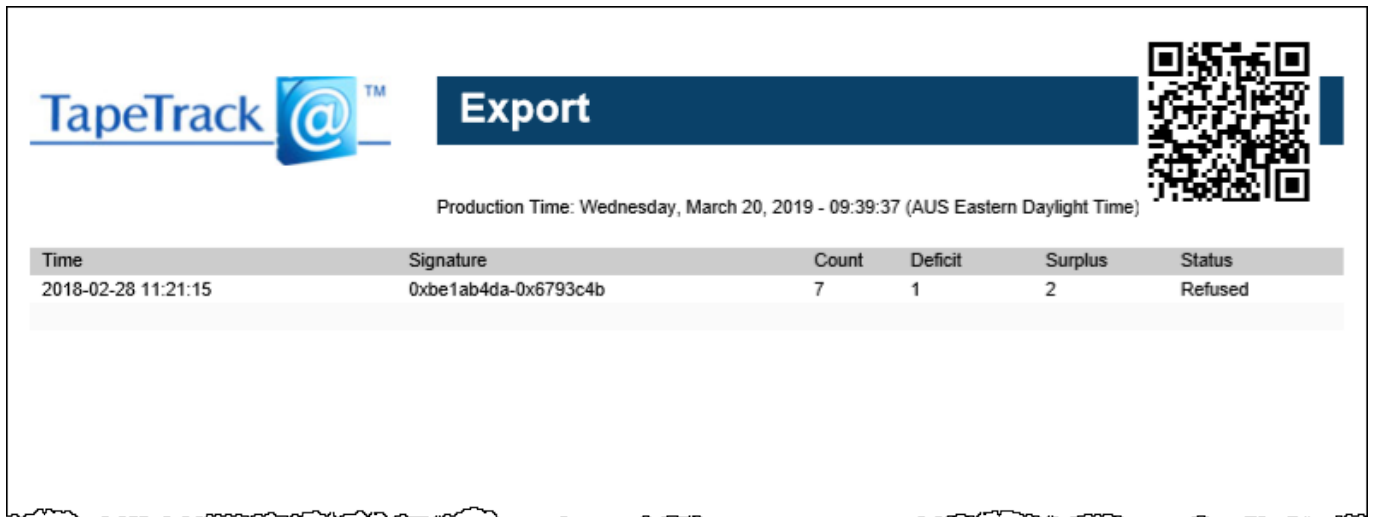

Press **Ctrl+E** on your keyboard to open the **Export** window.

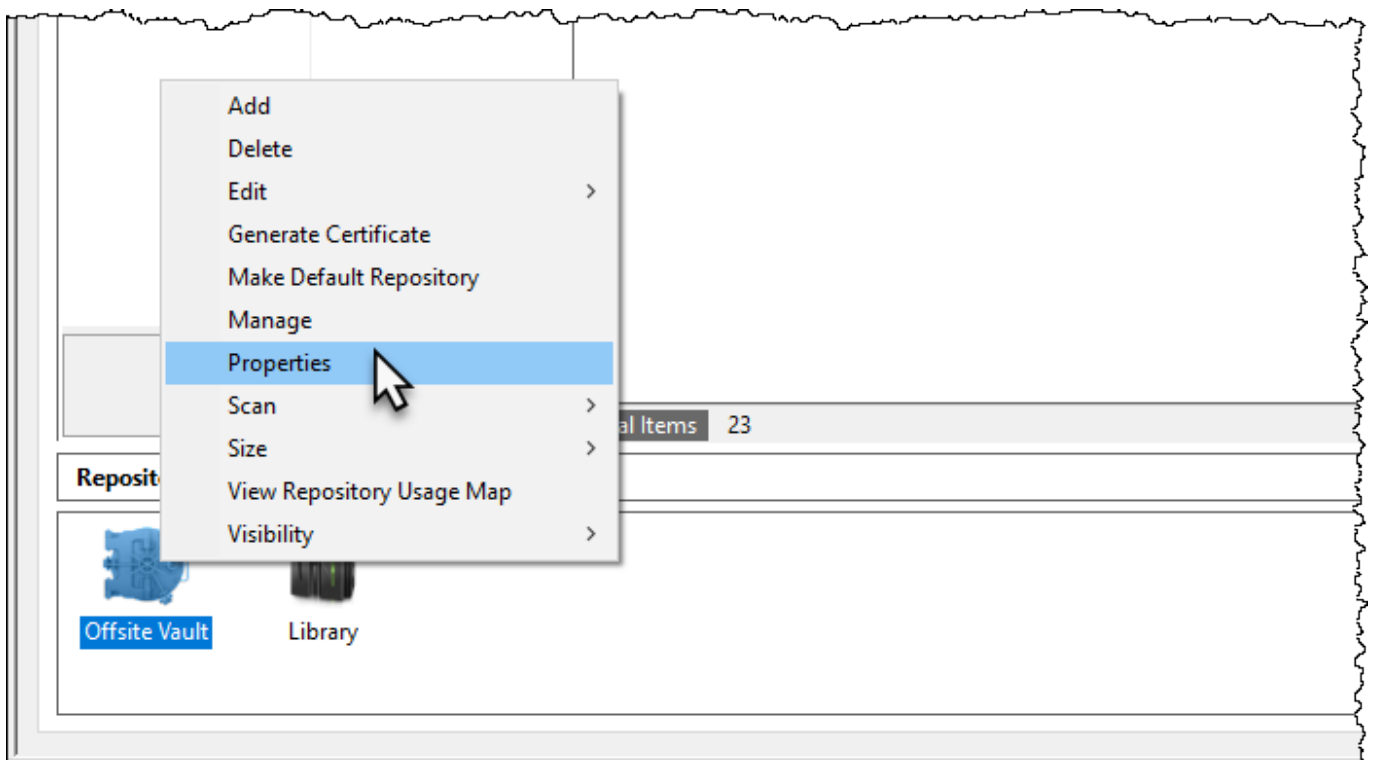


Select the export format and click **OK** and follow the prompts to save and open the exported file.



## Exporting Certificate Contents

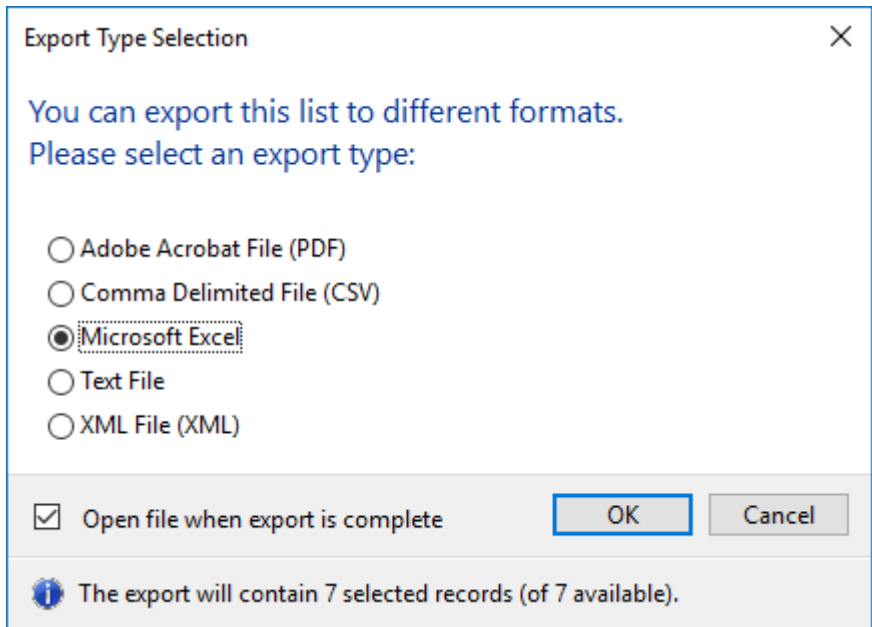

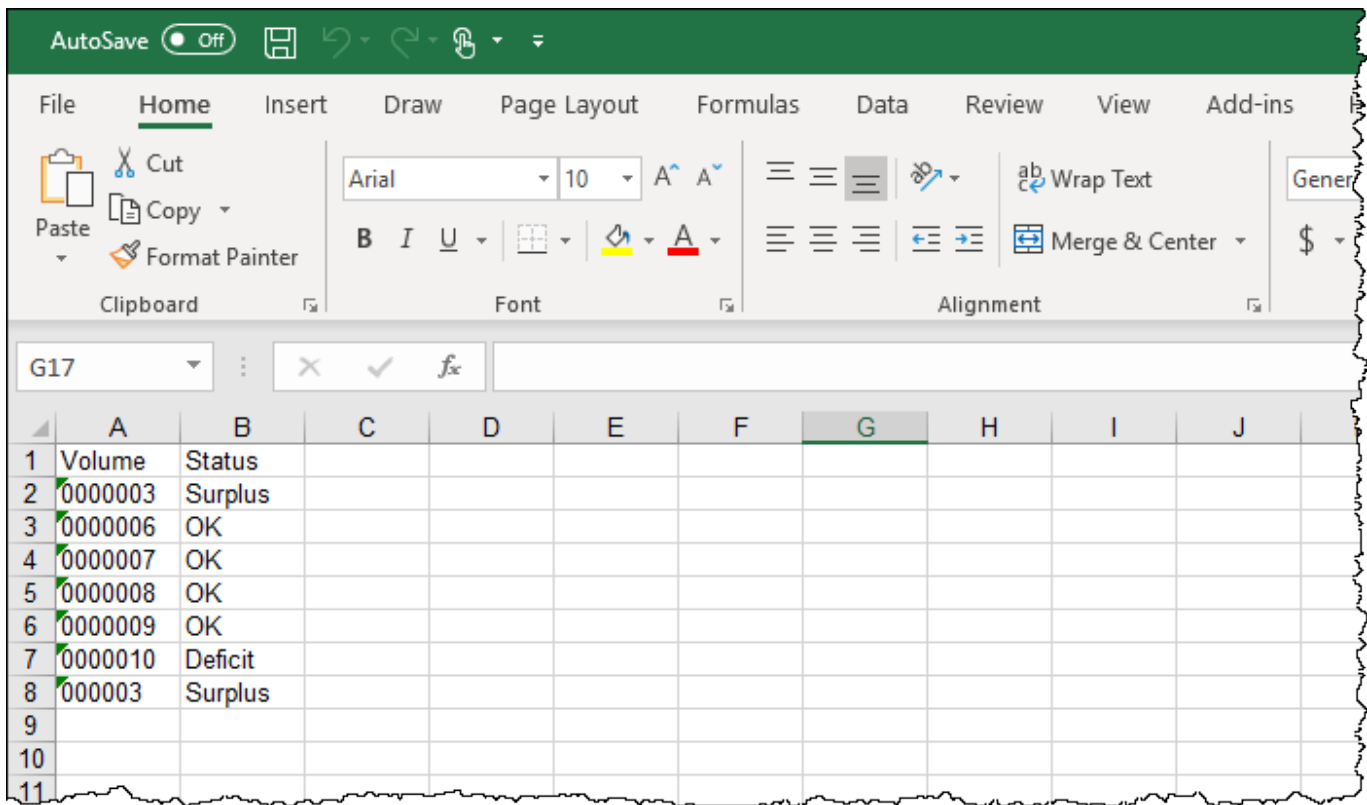
Right click and select [Properties](#), or double click, the required [Certificates](#) to open **Certificate** window.
