

Report Output Formats

Output from the Command Line Utilities can be redirected to a file, default format being a text file. Using Variables the output can be formatted to CSV, Excel, PDF, HTML or XML files.

Along with the file format, output path and headings can be customised, columns can be omitted from the report, output file name customised and portrait or landscape orientation and customised logo for PDF formats.

Text File

Capturing the output from Command Line Utilities is as simple as redirecting the standard output and providing the file name and directory path you want the file written to.

Example

Using TMSS10Inventory as an example Command Line Utility, outputting the standard output to a file named Inventory.txt in the directory

XML File
