

# Technote: Creating Reports

TapeTrack can produce reports two ways, through Desktop and Command Line programs.

## Desktop Programs

Reports can be created through the Desktop programs by selecting and filtering data and then exporting to a report.

This allows a quick and efficient creation of reports on demand.

Reports based over multiple Customer-ID's or Media-ID's can be produced through the Volume Global View function, of which results can be filtered down to required data and then exported to file.

When reporting on individual Media-ID's, the reports from the inventory window provide far more extensive options

## Command Line Programs

Reports that are required on a regular basis can be created using various command line programs that can then be saved to file, emailed and/or uploaded to the TapeTrack Server allowing clients to download without the need to create the reports themselves.

## Report Output

Both the Desktop and Command L Programs can produce reports in the following formats:

- Text
- HTML
- PDF
- CSV

Inventory	Produces a report of all Volumes that matches the supplied filters
