
## **Troubleshooter: Adding Volumes**

The purpose of this troubleshooter is to diagnose why Volumes in TapeTrack cannot be added.


## Security does not allow this operation

The error Security does not allow this operation indicates your User-ID does not have sufficient access rights to add volumes to TapeTrack.



To add Volumes you will need to either:

- Have you Administrator raise your access to include **Alter** rights.
- Have a User with Alter rights add the Volumes for you.



## **Target Repository Unknown**

The error Target Repository Unknown indicates that there is no current default Repository to add

new Volumes too.

To add new Volumes you will need to either:

- Set a current default Repository in TapeMaster by right clicking the required Repository and selecting Make Default Repository.
- Right click the required target Repository in TapeMaster and selecting Scan→To Add and Scan-In the new Volumes.
