


# Troubleshooter: Adding Volumes

The purpose of this troubleshooter is to diagnose why [Volumes](#) in TapeTrack cannot be added.


## Security does not allow this operation

The error **Security does not allow this operation** indicates your User-ID does not have sufficient access rights to add volumes to TapeTrack.



To add [Volumes](#) you will need to either:

- Have your Administrator [raise your access](#) to include Alter rights.
- Have a [User](#) with Alter rights add the [Volumes](#) for you.



## Target Repository Unknown

The error **Target Repository Unknown** indicates that there is no current default [Repository](#) to add

new [Volumes](#) too.

To add new [Volumes](#) you will need to either:

- Set a current default [Repository](#) in TapeMaster by right clicking the required [Repository](#) and selecting Make Default Repository.
- Right click the required target [Repository](#) in TapeMaster and selecting Scan→To Add and Scan-In the new [Volumes](#).
