

# TMSSDR0PREPORT

The [Environmental Variable](#) TMSSDR0PREPORT allows you to drop, or remove, a report section from command line report output based on the report ID. This can be of benefit if you only need one section of the report output.

TMSSDR0PREPORT is used in the format TMSSDR0PREPORT + the Report-ID, so for Report 100 the variable would be TMSSDR0PREPORT100.

New Variables can be set for multiple report sections based on the Report-ID's, for example Reports 100 and 110 you would set TMSSDR0PREPORT100 and TMSSDR0PREPORT110.

## Example

### Windows Command Line

```
set TMSSDR0PREPORT110=true
```

### Windows PowerShell

```
$env:TMSSDR0PREPORT11 = "true"
```
