

# TMSSDRPREPORT

The [Environmental Variable](#) TMSSDRPREPORT allows you to drop, or remove, a report section from command line report output based on the report ID. This can be of benefit if you only need one section of the report output.

TMSSDRPREPORT is used in the format TMSSDRPREPORT + the Report-ID, so for Report 100 the variable would be TMSSDRPREPORT100.

New Variables can be set for multiple report sections based on the Report-ID's, for example Reports 100 and 110 you would set TMSSDRPREPORT100 and TMSSDRPREPORT110.

## Example

### Windows Command Line

```
set TMSSDRPREPORT110=true
```

### Windows PowerShell

```
$env:TMSSDRPREPORT110 = "true"
```
