

# TMSSPPATH

By default, when TapeTrack Command Line Programs use the `-S` argument and:

1. Specify no password file, and
2. Don't use the prompt or literal password syntax.

then, the password will be loaded from:

- `C:\tapetrack\pw\user` (Windows)
- `\etc\tapetrack\pw\user` (all other platforms)

where, `user` is the name of the user that is logging-on.

When the [Environmental Variable](#) `TMSSPPATH` is set, the file will be loaded from the directory specified as the `TMSSPPATH` value.
