

TMSSERVERPROXY

The [Environmental Variable](#) TMSSERVERPROXY tells the TapeTrack Communications API to tunnel all TapeTrack communications via a HTTP proxy.

The value of TMSSERVERPROXY should be set in the format `user:password@server:port`, where:

- `user` (optional) is the user that will be connecting to the HTTP Proxy Server.
- `password` (optional) is the password of the user that is connecting to the HTTP Proxy Server.
- `server` (required) is the name or IP address of the HTTP Proxy Server.
- `port` (optional) is the TCP/IP port number of the HTTP Proxy Server.



When troubleshooting HTTP Proxy connections, you should consider using the [TMSSAPLLOGDIR](#) environmental variable.

Example

```
set TMSSERVERPROXY=jsmith:password@192.168.1.8:3128
```
