

TMSSSLACKICON

The [Environmental Variable](#) TMSSSLACKICON specifies the location of an icon to add to the Slack message.

Example

Windows Command Line

```
set TMSSSLACKICON=https://a.slack-edge.com/80588/img/icons/app-57.png
```


Windows PowerShell

```
$env:TMSSSLACKICON = "https://a.slack-edge.com/80588/img/icons/app-57.png"
```

Linux

```
export TMSSSLACKICON=https://a.slack-edge.com/80588/img/icons/app-57.png
```
