

# TMSSTDERRTERMINAL

The [Environmental Variable](#) TMSSTDERRTERMINAL displays the stderr on terminal, while still allowing it to be written to the file specified by TMSSTDERRDIR.

## Prerequisites

Variable TMSSTDERRDIR set to a valid file location.

## Example

### Windows Command Line

```
set TMSSTDERRTERMINAL=true
```

### Windows PowerShell

```
$env:TMSSTDERRTERMINAL = true
```

### Linux

```
export TMSSTDERRTERMINAL=true
```
